DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Ants are attracted to food, debris and low-frequency electronic noises. The plastic in AntGuardTM is impregnated with an insecticide that kills and repels ants. AntGuardTM is designed to withstand rain, sun and the elements for 6 to 9 months of control.

Apply AntGuard™ to any pole, pipe, cable, rope, shaft or other outside surfaces where crawling insects can be deterred by interrupting routes of travel, such as:

pilings
mooring lines
docks
shrubs
plants (such as camellias)
trees
greenhouse structures
utility tunnels and chases
boats
outdoor furniture and tables

cables
electrical conduits and switches
outdoor lights
outdoor storage racks and bins
pallet storage areas
telephone lines - cable TV
junction and interface boxes

AntGuardTM is a plastic cylindrical device impregnated with an insecticide that kills or repels ants. Fasten AntGuardTM around points of entry to interrupt the route of travel of insects.

Do not open package until ready to use. Remove protective wrap from AntGuardTM device. Wear protective gloves when handling the device. Attach AntGuardTM at the point of entry of the particular use site, with the flared open end pointing toward the ground or away from the point of entry. See illustration. Use the attachment clips included to secure AntGuardTM firmly to the site. For growing sites, such as shrubs and plants, use the black flexible clip to secure AntGuardTM. This clip will allow for the shrub or plant to grow unimpeded. AntGuardTM will begin to kill and control ants within 24 hours. Under normal conditions AntGuardTM will give 6 to 9 months of centrol.

To remove AntGuardTM use clippers or strong scissors to cut the attachment clip. Dispose of clip and used AntGuardTM by wrapping in newspaper and placing in trash.

For use on boats, pilings, mooring lines and docks:

- Helps guard from crawling insect infestation at points of entry.
- Easy to apply.

AntGuardTM for is a plastic cylindrical device impregnated with an insecticide that kills or repels ants. Fasten AntGuardTM around pilings, mooring, electrical and water lines and docks to prevent insect infestation on boats.

Do not open package until ready to use. Remove protective wrap from AntGuardTM device. Attach AntGuardTM at the point on mooring, electrical or water lines that will avoid contact with water, with the flared open end pointing toward the dock. See illustration. Use the attachment clips included to secure AntGuardTM firmly to the site. AntGuardTM will begin to kill and control ants within 24 hours.
