It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Ants are attracted to food, debris and low-frequency electronic noises. The plastic in AntGuard™ is impregnated with an insecticide that kills and repels ants. AntGuard™ is designed to withstand rain, sun and the elements for 6 to 9 months of control.

Apply AntGuard™ to any pole, pipe, cable, rope, shaft or other outside surfaces where crawling insects can be deterred by interrupting routes of travel, such as:

AntGuard™ is a plastic cylindrical device impregnated with an insecticide that kills or repels ants. Fasten AntGuard™ around points of entry to interrupt the route of travel of insects.

Do not open package until ready to use. Remove protective wrap from AntGuard™ device. Wear protective gloves when handling the device. Attach AntGuard™ at the point of entry of the particular use site, with the flared open end pointing toward the ground or away from the point of entry. See illustration. Use the attachment clips included to secure AntGuard™ firmly to the site. For growing sites, such as shrubs and plants, use the black flexible clip to secure AntGuard™. This clip will allow for the shrub or plant to grow unimpeded. AntGuard™ will begin to kill and control ants within 24 hours. Under normal conditions AntGuard™ will give 6 to 9 months of control.

To remove AntGuard™ use clippers or strong scissors to cut the attachment clip. Dispose of clip and used AntGuard™ by wrapping in newspaper and placing in trash.

For use on boats, pilings, mooring lines and docks:

- Helps guard from crawling insect infestation at points of entry.
- Easy to apply.

AntGuard™ for is a plastic cylindrical device impregnated with an insecticide that kills or repels ants. Fasten AntGuard™ around pilings, mooring, electrical and water lines and docks to prevent insect infestation on boats.

Attach AntGuard™ at the point on mooring, electrical or water lines that will avoid contact with water, with the flared open end pointing toward the dock. See illustration. Use the attachment clips included to secure AntGuard™ firmly to the site. AntGuard™ will begin to kill and control ants within 24 hours. Under normal conditions AntGuard™ will give 6 to 9 months of control.

To remove AntGuard™ use clippers or strong scissors to cut the attachment clip. Dispose of clip and used AntGuard™ by wrapping in newspaper and placing in trash.
