- Apply 4 oz. of The Yellow Stuff per 10,000 gallons as claffected areas as possible. For severe accumulations, above dosage.
- Superchlorinate by following directions of that product's laber

Swimming may be resumed a few hours after treatment.

WEEKLY MAINTENANCE TREATMENT:

To prevent accumulation of yellow algae: (All dosages are gallons of water).

- With water temperature over 80°F, add 4 oz. The Yellow 5 gallon liquid chlorine or 1 pound of a dry chlorine once a wee
- With water temperature under 80°F, add 2 oz. The Yellow S and ½ gallon liquid chlorine or ½ pound of a dry chlorine.
