The Agency has reviewed your label amendment submitted in accordance with continuing registration under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, and determined the action acceptable with the addition of the following comment:

Add "or the bromine level is below 4 ppm as measured by a bromine test kit" to "Swimming may be resumed several (or few) hours after treatment" as indicated twice on label.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To remove visible yellow or mustard algae: (All dosages are for 10,000 gallons of water).

1. Brush walls and floor areas affected by yellow algae accumulations.

2. Apply 4 oz. of The Yellow Stuff per 10,000 gallons as close to the affected areas as possible.

For severe accumulations, double the above dosage.

3. Super-chlorinate by following directions of that product's label.

Swimming may be resumed a few hours after treatment, or the bromine level is below 4 ppm as measured weekly maintenance treatment.

To prevent accumulation of yellow algae: (All dosages are for 10,000 gallons of water).

1. With water temperature over 80°F, add 4 oz. The Yellow Stuff with one gallon liquid chlorine or one pound of a dry chlorine once a week. pound of a dry chlorine once a week.

2. With water temperature under 80°F, add 2 oz. The Yellow Stuff weekly and 1/2 gallon liquid chlorine or 1/2 pound of a dry chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area, that is inaccessible to small children, away from heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: To avoid waste, use all material in this container according to label directions. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. If empty, place in trash or offer for recycling, if available. If partly filled, call your local solid water agency for disposal instructions.
