2. Change EPA File Symbol 62481-E to EPA Registration Number 62481-2.
3. Change available chlorine to 89%.
4. In Directions for Use, change chlorine residual upper range from 2.0 ppm to 1.5 ppm.
5. At bottom of Directions for Use, add "Reentry into treated hot tubs/spas is prohibited above levels of 3 ppm of chlorine as measured by appropriate test kit."
6. At bottom of Hazards to Humans paragraph add "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."
7. Delete "Practical Treatment" and revise First Aid as follows:

FIRST AID	
IF IN EYES	Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
IF INHALED	Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment.

SPA-MAGIC® Oxidizing Tablets are to be used as a disinfectant and algae control. Load two 0.5 oz. tablets every seven days into the cartridge intended to slowly meter chlorine into the water.

START-UP: When starting up a reopened or freshly filled hot tub or spa, make sure that the filtration system is clean and operating properly. If necessary, adjust pH to 7.2-7.6 and total alkalinity to 80-100ppm. Chlorinate the water while the circulating system is operating and the aeration shut off.

DAILY: Using a test kit as a daily guide, maintain free chlorine residual of the water at 1.0 - 2.0ppm. For best results, maintain a pH of 7.2 - 7.6. If below, add pH Up. If pH is above 7.6, add pH Down.
