PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION. Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Harmful if Inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Avoid breathing dust. Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes, socks, and chemical-resistant gloves made out of any waterproof material such as polyethylene or polyvinyl chloride or made of any waterproof material. Prolonged or repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.

FIRST AID:

If Swallowed:	Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If on Skin or Clothing:	Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.	

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): Applicators and other handlers must wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, and shoes plus socks. Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. User Safety Recommendations:

AGRICULTURAL USE:

To assure freshness by the fungicidal control of *Botrytis cinerea* on table grapes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

1. Pad content should never come in direct contact with table grapes.
2. Do not use defective pad, e.g. torn pad or broken seal.
3. Use a polyethylene liner in an appropriate shipping container.
4. Cover bottom of the polyethylene liner with fine wood shavings or other suitable packing material.
5. A sheet of tissue may be placed on the packing material and over the sides of the box.
6. Tissue-wrap grape bunches, if desired, and pack in box.
7. If tissue is used, fold it over the top of the grapes.
8. Lay a single pad containing sodium metabisulfite over the tissue. Do not place more than 1 pad for each 8.2 kg (18.0 lbs.) of table grapes.
9. Fold the polyethylene liner over the pad. Seal the box.
10. Place the boxes of packed grapes in refrigerated storage at 0°-2°C (32°-35.6°F).
11. This pad must be removed and disposed of prior to displaying grapes for sale. Do not allow consumers access to pads.
12. If pad is torn, carefully dispose of pad, pad contents, and grapes which have contacted pad contents. Hold remainder of contents for 24 hours before displaying.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Keep this product in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat and flame.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA regional office for guidance. In case of decomposition, isolate container and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding this container. Flush wash water down the sewer. Collect used and damaged pads in a plastic bag, seal bag, and place in an outdoor trash receptacle (dumpster).

Container Disposal: Individual Pads: Non-refillable pads. Do not reuse or refill pads. Offer for recycling, if available. If recycling is not available, collect used pads in a plastic bag, seal bag, and place in an outdoor trash receptacle (dumpster). Outside Shipping Container: Non-refillable container. Do not re-use or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available.

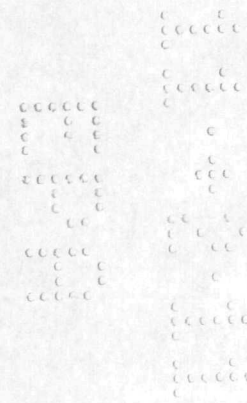
