The amended labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with reregistration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following comments:

1. Include the following general information either near the first aid statement or the emergency phone number:

*"Have the product container or label with you when calling
a Poison Control Center or doctor or going for treatment."*

2. Delete the word, "etc" from the use sites.
3. For residential use products, EPA will accept the term, "Wear eye protection or "safety glasses" in the precautionary section.



For badly discolored bowls due to lime and rust, remove water from bowl and brush out with 4-8 oz of cleaner. **To Disinfect:** *Remove water from bowl.* Cover bowl surface with cleaner, let stand for at least 10 minutes, brush thoroughly and flush. Do not use or place on toilet lids, sinks, vanities, bathtubs, countertops, etc. **Do Not Mix With Bleach, Ammonia or Other Household Chemical Products.** For use in homes, schools, hospitals, etc.

(Call a Poison Control Center or Doctor Immediately for Treatment Advice)

IF SWALLOWED	DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Have person sip a glass of water only if conscious and able to swallow.
IF IN EYES	Hold eye open and rinse gently with water for 5 minutes. Remove contact lens if present, then continue rinsing with water for an additional 15 minutes.
IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING	Remove contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
IF INHALED	Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911, then give artificial respiration if possible.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
