Label Comments:

- NOTE: In a letter dated 7/10/03, Kittrich requested that the previous product name be replaced with the **additional** brand name, "Pretty Please Bug Kill Shelf Paper." Please note that "Pretty Please Bug Kill Shelf Paper" has been designated as the **primary** brand name. The primary brand name is the name that must appear on labels submitted to the Agency for official action, as only labels bearing the primary brand name will be stamped. The primary brand name must also appear on the CSF.
- Under the product name, the phrase "Kills Roaches, Ants, Silverfish" must be modified to read, "Kills Roaches, Ants (**excluding fire, harvester, carpenter, and pharaoh ants**), Silverfish."
- Under the First Aid section, it is recommended that you use the format specified in Pesticide Registration (PR) Notice 2001-1. It is also recommended that you provide an emergency information telephone number, as described in PR Notice 2001-1.
- Under the Application Instructions section, **delete the word "most"** so the first sentence reads, "This product is effective during the first 3 weeks after installation..." An extended efficacy claim must be supported by additional data.
- Under the Application Instructions section, **correct the spelling of "pharaoh ants"** and **move the exclusion statement directly after the word "ants"** so the sentence reads, "...in killing American and German roaches, ants (excluding fire, harvester, carpenter, and pharaoh ants), and silverfish.
- Within the Storage and Disposal Box, **add the heading "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL."**
- Under the Storage and Disposal section, modify the text as follows: "...Call your local solid waste agency **or 1-800-CLEANUP** for disposal instructions."

Replace product when effectiveness diminishes or paper becomes soiled. Use this product to line drawers and cabinets; use in storage areas and around garbage areas. Put under sinks and in broom closets and other secluded areas where insects may congregate. Use in basement areas and other damp areas.

STORAGE: Store in original container away from food and foodstuffs. Keep product in locked storage area inaccessible to children and pets. **DISPOSAL:** If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
