

Environmental hazards: This product is toxic to birds do not apply directly to water. **Directions for use** It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **READ THIS LABEL:** read this entire label and follow all use directions and use precautions. **IMPORTANT:** Do not expose children, pets or other non-target animals to rodenticides.

To help prevent accidents: 1. Store product not in use in a location out of the reach of children and pets. 2. Apply bait in locations out of reach of children, pets, domestic animals and non-target wildlife, or in tamper resistant bait stations. These stations must be resistant to destruction by dogs and by children under 6 years of age, must be used in a manner that prevents such children from reaching into bait compartments and obtaining bait. If bait can be shaken from stations when they are lifted, units must be secured or otherwise immobilized. Even stronger bait stations are needed in areas open to hoofed livestock, raccoons, bears, or other potentially destructive animals prone to vandalism. 3. Dispose of product container and unused, spoiled and unconsumed bait as specified on this label.

USE RESTRICTIONS: for control of Norway rats, roof rats and house mice in and around homes, industrial buildings, and similar man made structures. Do not place

bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come in direct contact with food. Do not broadcast bait.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: determine areas where rats or mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these are along walls, by gnawed openings in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS: Rats: apply 4 to 16 oz. of bait per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days. The amount of bait in this container is unlikely to be sufficient to kill more than 2 or 3 rats.

Mice: Apply 1/4 to 1/2 oz. (1-2 level tablespoons) of bait at 8-10 foot intervals. Larger placement (up to 2 oz.) may be needed at points of very high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days.

Rats/Mice: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and leftover bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish as much as needed.

Storage: Store in original container, in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: call your local solid waste agency or call 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
