2. Make the label changes listed below before releasing the product for shipment:
 - a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 62635-1" to the label.
 - b. The upper and lower certified limits (CSF columns 14a and 14b) for the dye contained in the product formulation (Sumiplast Blue OA or Oracet Blue 2R) are incorrectly declared on the Confidential Statement of Formula. As per the Agency letter dated March 26, 1991, the certified limits should represent low and high values around the nominal concentration.
 - c. Provide the identification and chemical composition of Oracet Blue 2R.


3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

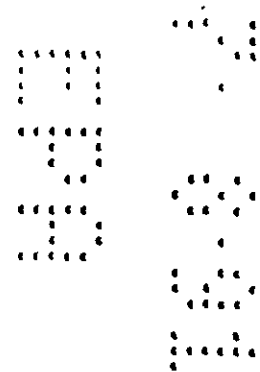
