SPECIFIC APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS: BMP 144 (200 G) should be applied uniformly in conventional aerial and ground equipment. A seven to fourteen day interval between applications should be employed. Longer periods of mosquito population suppression may result where sufficient numbers of non-target aquatic, invertebrate parasites and predators are present, since these are not affected by BMP 144 (200 G) and contribute to mosquito population reduction.

CAUTION: Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.
