DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
This product kills fleas in turf, dog kennels and exercise runs for up to 4 weeks, even when it rains. Also kills many other yard insects such as Ants, Chiggers, Crickets, Cutworms, Grasshoppers, Mosquitoes and Spiders.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING! Invert bottle and shake for 20 seconds before pouring or before attaching sprayer top-hose connector. For pressure spray tanks, use 2 fl. oz. (4 tablespoonsfull) of Yard & Kennel Spray Concentrate in 1 gallon of water for every 160 square feet of yard or dog run surface to be treated. This bottle (32 fl. oz.), when diluted in 16 gallons of water, will treat up to 2540 square feet. To use with the hose end sprayer top, attach top to garden hose and then to the bottle. Invert the bottle and shake again before turning on hose and valve on sprayer top. Slowly sweep over the area to be treated, moving steadily until the spray has been used and the area covered. When bottle is empty, remove and rinse sprayer top and bottle. Repeat treatment as necessary
To Control Fire Ants, use 8 fl. oz. (16 tablespoonsfull) of Yard & Kennel Spray Concentrate in 1 gallon of water. Stir occasionally during use to keep the product mixed properly. Using a sprinkler can, thoroughly wet mound and surrounding areas to a 4 ft diameter. Apply during cool weather, 65-80°F. or in early morning or late evening. Apply to new mounds as they appear. Do not disturb mounds before treatment. If possible, treat all mounds in the vicinity and all colonies that may not as yet have raised mounds.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND

CAUTION May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes thoroughly after handling. Do not clean food and food utensils by use, storage or disposal. **SPRAY ON HUMANS OR PETS.** Kittens under 12 weeks old may be harmed. Avoid treating bedding or other items that pets may have prolonged direct contact with. Keep children out of treated areas until sprayed area has dried.
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
If swallowed: Call a physician or hospital. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting. Do not induce vomiting if the person is unconscious. If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash with soap and water. If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Call a physician.

Note to physician and veterinarian: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor, treat symptomatically by injection if an antidote is available. 2-PAM is an antidote, but only in conjunction with atropine.
Environmental hazards: This product is toxic to wildlife and birds. Do not apply directly to water, lakes or streams or to disposal of wastes or equipment which may contaminate water or food plants.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
STORAGE: Store in original container. Do not freeze or store above 100°F.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse container and put in trash.
