5. It is recommended that you add a NOTE TO PHYSICIAN subsection to the end of the FIRST AID section.
6. Revise the statement "N-Serve TG nitrogen stabilizer may be used for formulation into other manufacturing use products or end-use products for use on corn, sorghum, and wheat" to "N-Serve TG nitrogen stabilizer may be used for formulation into other manufacturing use products or end-use products for use as a nitrification inhibitor on corn, sorghum, and wheat."
7. In the section STORAGE AND DISPOSAL, add a PESTICIDE DISPOSAL subsection with appropriate directions for pesticide disposal. Also, add a CONTAINER DISPOSAL subsection with directions for container disposal when recycling is not available or if disposal of the refillable container is desired.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container above 28°F. In case of leak or spill, contain material with absorbent materials and dispose as waste.

Nonrefillable containers 5 gallons or less:

Container Reuse: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling if available.

Triple rinse or pressure rinse container (or equivalent) promptly after emptying. **Triple rinse** as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container 1/4 full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. **Pressure rinse** as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over application equipment or mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over application equipment or mix tank or collect rinsate for later use or disposal. Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 psi for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip.

Refillable containers 5 gallons or larger:

Container Reuse: Refillable container. Refill this container with pesticide only. Do not reuse this container for any other purpose.

Cleaning the container before final disposal is the responsibility of the person disposing of the container. Cleaning before refilling is the responsibility of the refiller. To clean the container before final disposal, empty the remaining contents from this container into application equipment or a mix tank. Pour or pump rinsate into application equipment or rinsate collection system. Repeat this rinsing procedure two more times.
