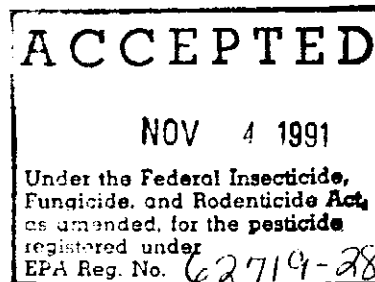

If Inhaled: Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Call a physician.

Note to Physician: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, only by injection, is the preferable antidote. Oximes, such as 2-PAM/protopam, may be therapeutic if used early; however, use only in conjunction with atropine. In case of severe acute poisoning, use antidotes immediately after establishing an open airway and respiration.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperature above 130°F may cause bursting.

Dursban Flea Spray for Dogs Kills Fleas for Up to One Month.

Important Consumer Information

Dursban flea spray for dogs kills fleas for up to one month. It contains Dursban insecticide, an effective flea killing ingredient, used by professional exterminators.

Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Place dog on a table or bench, preferably out of doors. Hold can in upright position 3-6" from the dog and thoroughly spray all over the body against the lay of the coat. Avoid spraying in eyes. Spray to leave the coat slightly damp down to skin level. Spraying time should be between 30 and 60 seconds on a medium sized dog. This can should provide 4-6 complete treatments.

One treatment will kill fleas and protect against reinfestation for up to one month. Repeat treatment as necessary. Spray bedding and sleeping areas.

Attention: Use of this product in confined or poorly ventilated areas, such as small rooms, can result in levels of solvent vapors which can cause dizziness and eye irritation. Use only in well-ventilated, non-confined areas, or provide a source of ventilation to avoid the build-up of solvent vapors.

NOTE

- Do not use on cats.
- Do not use on dogs nursing puppies or on pups under 10 weeks old.
- Free bitches from fleas before they bear pups.
- Use only as directed . Intentional misuse by deliberately concentrating and inhaling the contents can be harmful or fatal.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture can. Do not store near heat.
