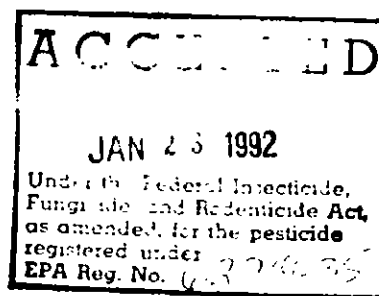

Ornamentals (Soil Treatment)

Use Professional Turf Insecticide to treat potted, containerized, and balled and burlapped nursery stock to control the insects in the soil attached to the roots of these plants. Completely submerge the ball of soil in a tank containing diluted Professional Turf Insecticide. Do not remove burlap wrap or plastic containers with drain holes prior to submerging. Keep soil submerged until complete saturation has occurred, normally about 30 seconds.

Note: Wear chemically resistant gloves, boots, and apron during this operation. Application should be made in a well-ventilated area.

Note: Environmental factors significantly affect phytotoxicity. Professional Turf Insecticide has been tested on numerous ornamental plants without causing serious phytotoxicity. However, because of the numerous varieties grown, it is recommended that a small group of plants be treated at the recommended rate under the anticipated growing conditions and observed for phytotoxic symptoms for at least 7 days, before a large number of plants are treated.
