



GENERAL INFORMATION

TURFLON Amine Herbicide is recommended for the control of annual and perennial broadleaf weeds actively growing intall fescue, perennial bluegrass, or perennial ryegrass ornamental furf.

Among the annual and perennial broadlest weeds controlled are:

Bindweed Burdock Cenade Thietle Chicory Curty Dock

Dendellon

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Do not use for manufacturing or formulating.

Mixing Instructions

Use TURFLON Amine Herbicide at rates of ½ to 2 quarts per acre to control broadlesf weeds. In all cases use the amount specified in enough water to give uniform and complete coverage of the plants to be controlled. Use only water suitable for spraying. The recommended order of addition to the spray tank is water, Nalco-Trol (if used), surfactant (if used), additional herbicide (if used), TURFLON Amine Herbicide. If combined with emulaflable concentrate herbicides, moderate combinious adequate agitation is required.

Application Directions

Broadcast Treatment of Orne mental Turf: Foliage sprays should be applied during warm weather, early spring through fall, when weeds are actively growing. Application under drought conditions may provide less than desirable results. Use low spray pressures to in remize spray drift. (See Use Precautions.) When hard-to-control species are prevalent and during applications made in late summer when the plants are mature and during drought conditions, use the higher rates.

Make application using equipment that will assure unform coverage of the apray volumes applied. TO IMPROVE SPRAY COVERAGE, ADD AN AGRICULTURAL SURFACTANT (SUCH AS ORTHO X-77 or TRONGC) AT A RATE OF % TO 1 PINT PER ACRE, USE THE HIGHER RATES OF SURFACTANT FOR LOWER RATES OF PRODUCT AND LOWER SPRAY VOLUMES.

Apply 1/s to 2 quarts of TURFLON Amine Herbicide in 26-55-30-300-gallens of water per acre to control broadles! weeds actively growing in tail feacue, bluegrass or perennial ryegrass turf. DO NOT use on other species, such as beingrass or St. Augustine grass, unless injury can be tolerated. To minimize grass injury, do not treat if grass is under heat or drought stress, and repest applications should be made at least four weeks apart.

Apply TURFLON Amine Herbicide in a mariner to avoid contacting nearby susceptible crops or other desirable plants. Very small amounts of spray drift may injure susceptible plants, including ornamental trees and shrubs. DO NOT apply to exposed roots of shallow rooted trees or shrubs.

Broadleaf weed species germinate at different times before being treated. Only emerged weeds present at the time of application will be controlled. Newly seeded turt should be moved two or three times before being treated. Do not water for 24 hours after application. Do not reseed for 3 weeks after application.

Spot Treatment of Ornamental Turf Using Portable Sprayers: Mix 1.0 to 1.25 fluid ounces of TURFLON Amine in enough water to make 3 gallons of spray (1 to 1.25 querts per 100 gallons of spray) and apply at any time broadleaf weeds are susceptible by wetting foliage of undesirable plants to the point of runoff. Do not apply more than 2½ quarts of TURFLON Amine on any one acre.

Do not apply TURFLON Amine Herbicide directly to, or otherwise permit it to come into direct contact with grapes, tobacco, vegetable crops, flowers or other desirable broadlest plants and do not permit spray mists containing it to drift into them.

Avoid injurious Spray Driff: Applications should be made only when there is little or no hezard from spray drift. Very small quantities of spray, which may not be visible, may senously injure susceptible plants. Do not spray when wind is blowing toward susceptible crops or ornamental plants near enough to be injured.

In handgun applications, drift can be reduced by using low pressure Teejet flat fan, raindrop, or other drift controlling nozzles. Standard flat fan nozzles may also be used at no more than 20 per. At this pressure the spray pattern may be narrower.

With ground broadcast equipment, drift can be reduced by keeping the spray boom as low as possible; by applying no less than 35-gallens of spray per acre; by using no more than 20 pounds of spraying pressure with flat fan or flooding fan tips; and by spraying when wind velocity is low.


