Your amendment application submission dated
June 26, 1997

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. Revise the Precautionary Statement to read as the following:

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes or on skin and clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

b. Revise the Oral Statement of Practical Treatment to read as the following:

If swallowed: Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelation solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol.

These changes are consistent with and reflect the labeling of the registered product being repacked.

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

First Aid

If swallowed: Induce vomiting by giving two glasses of water and sticking finger down throat. Call a physician. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is extremely toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For further guidance, contact your state water board or regional office of the EPA.

Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Do not store in freezing temperatures. If allowed to freeze, remix before using. Do not transport with or store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your state pesticide or environmental control agency, or the hazardous waste representative at the nearest EPA regional office for guidance.

Container Disposal: Completely empty bag into manufacturing equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
