
The Agency acknowledges receipt of your request to delete the use site, rice from the product label. A notice of receipt of your request to delete this use was published in the Federal Register on December 2, 1998 [Vol. 63/No. 231:66542]. The 180-day public comment period on the use deletion notice has ended. This letter is to notify you that the use site, rice has been officially deleted from the subject product's registration. The labeling is acceptable. Please submit one copy of the final printed labeling for the subject product with this use deleted. As specified in the above-mentioned Federal Register notice, you may sell or distribute product bearing the previously approved rice labeling for a period of 18 months from the date of this letter.

The Agency has recently revised its first aid recommendations for pesticides. For future label amendments, please use the currently recommended statements shown on the enclosed chart.
