Directions For Use

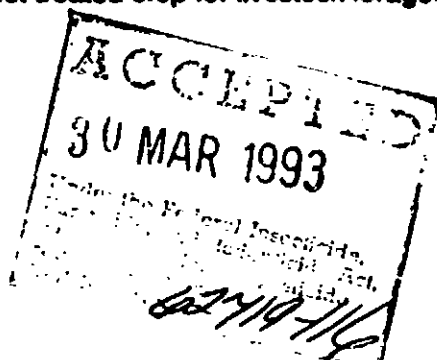
Apply as a soil incorporated treatment in the spring before planting or in late summer or early fall before a fall planting. Follow soil preparation, application and incorporation directions on Treflan product labels.

Precautions

- Do not apply to rapeseed (canola) or crambe grown in the state of Alaska.
- Where applications are made in late summer or fall, plant as rotation crops in the season following application only those crops for which Treflan may be applied as a preplant incorporated treatment or crop injury may occur.
- Do not graze or harvest treated crop for livestock forage.
