Fleid Cultivators: With 3 or 4 rows of sweeps, spaced at intervals of 7 inches or less and staggered so that no soil is left unturned. Operate at a speed of 5 mph or more. Chisel points should not be used. Bes, results will be obtained when field cultivators are equipped with harrow, reel or basket attachments.

Finishing Disc: With disc blades no greater than 22 inches in diameter, spaced no more than 7 1/2 inches apart. Operate at a speed of 4 to 6 mph. Best results will be obtained when the disc is equipped with harrow, reel or basket attachments.

Combination Implement: With three or more tillage devices combined and used as a single tool. Operate at a speed of 5 mph or more.

PTO Driven Equipment: Tillers, cultivators or hoes.
