- For treated smaller areas, a small rotary applicator is recommended. To insure proper coverage and avoid missed areas, early morning treatment when wheel tracks are evident in the dew and the wind is calm is recommended.
- When using tractor mounted or pull-type rotary applicators, early morning applications when the wind is calm and dew is on the ground is recommended. Wheel tracks are evident in the dew and granules can be spread uniformly.

Successful preemergence control of the annual grass weeds listed on this label requires proper timing of application. Apply Team 2G approximately 1 to 2 weeks prior to the germination of annual grass weeds. If application timing does not coincide with the normal germination period of any of the annual grass weeds listed on this label, weed control results may be erratic or poor.

Spring Germinating Summer Grasses (Crabqrasses, Goosegrasses, Foxtails, Barnyardgrass)

- Northern Cool Season Turfgrass: For preemergence control, apply 75 to 120 lb of Team 2G per acre.
   Apply in the spring, 1 to 2 weeks prior to the onset of conditions favorable for annual grass weed seed germination. Where heavy goosegrass pressure exists, use the rate of 120 lb of Team 2G per acre.
