
The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, successfully REMOVES THE PRODUCT FROM THE SCOPE of PR Notice 93-7 once the comments (if any) on the attached sheet are addressed. Other than the alterations (if any) listed on the attached sheet, no further alterations to the labeling are necessary to reflect the requirements of the Worker Protection Standard.

Since your amendment proposes to delete uses directly and/or to delete uses implicitly through the use of exclusionary statements, the Agency will publish in the Federal Register a notice of receipt of your amendment to delete uses, as required by section 6(f)(1) of FIFRA. The Agency will defer action for 90 days from the date of the Federal Register notice to give affected minor users an opportunity to try to persuade you to retain the uses(s). When the comment period has expired, the Agency will approve the amendment unless you have withdrawn it, and stamp the amended labeling "accepted." Your stamped-accepted labeling will then be sent to you.

As described in Supplement A of PR Notice 93-11 (self-verification option), you may sell and distribute product bearing the submitted labeling before you receive a copy of your stamped-accepted labeling. Note that your registration is not amended until the comment period required by section 6(f)(1) of FIFRA has expired and the Agency has approved the amendment. Therefore, you may withdraw your proposed amendment at any time during the comment period and until you receive your stamped-accepted labeling.

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General Information

This turl fertilizer product contains Team herbicide, a preemergence herbicide which is applied to established turfgrasses for the control of the winter annual grass: annual bluegrass (*Poa Annua*); and summer annual grasses: smooth and hairy crabgrass, goosegrass (silver crabgrass or crowfootgrass), barrryardgrass (watergrass) and green and yellow foxtail. This product also provides partial control of prostrate spurge (*Euphorbia humistrata*), spotted spurge (*Euphorbia maculata*), creeping spurge (*Euphorbia maculata*), creeping woodsorrel (*Oxalis comiculata*) and yellow woodsorrel (*Oxalis stricta*).

Important Use Precautions:

Reseating: Do not reseed treated areas for minimum of 8 weeks after a single application of 174 pounds per acre or 12 to 16 weeks after a single application of 260 pounds per acre. For split applications, do not reseed treated areas for 8 to 10 weeks after the last 130 pounds per acre rate or 10 to 12 weeks after the last 174 pounds per acre rate.

Do not apply this product to golf course putting greens, dichondra, or newly spngged areas of bermudagrass. St. Augustinegrass, centipedegrass, or zoysiagrass. Any cultural practices that disturb the soil, such as aerification or verticulting, should be done prior to application.

Application

This product should be applied one to two weeks prior to the anticipated germination of the target annual weeds. Apply using a property calibrated granular fertilizer spreader which will uniformly distribute the product over the target area. Avoid skips and excessive overlaps as poor weed control or turigrass injury may occur. Optimum weed control performance will be obtained if treated areas are irrigated soon after application. This product will not harm most nearby ornamentals.

In areas with extended growing seasons or where desired, a second application at the recommended rate can be made 8 to 10 weeks following the initial application on cool season turfgrasses and 10 to 12 weeks following the initial application on warm season turfgrasses.

Split Applications for Extended Control and Lawn Care Operator Programs:

As an alternative to single application programs, DowElanco Turf Fertilizer containing Team may also be applied in split applications. This program is desirable when the initial application is made well in advance of weed germination and where weed control is desired for a longer period of time.

Apply DowElanco Fertilizer containing Team at 130 pounds plus 130 pounds per acre for Cool Season Turigrasses and in the northern half of the Warm Season Turigrass area of the U.S. or 174 pounds plus 174 pounds per acre in the southern half of the Warm Season Turigrasses area of the U.S. The second application should be made 8 to 10 weeks following the 130 pounds per acre rate and 10 to 12 weeks following the 174 pounds per acre rate.
