Add the following: "For formulation into end-use herbicide products intended only for use on fruit, nuts, vineyards, (bearing and non-bearing), soybeans, cotton (Texas only), peas (English and Green), tobacco (air and flue-cured), potatoes (white), small grains (wheat and barley), forestry and Christmas tree plantations, established ornamentals and noncropland areas."
4. Add the statement "Protective clothing (coveralls, long-sleeved shirt, gloves and impermeable shoes) must be worn when handling this chemical."
5. Incorporate the words "Manufacturing Use" into the name of the above mentioned product or use another name that is not already in use by your company, as discussed with Steve Morrill.

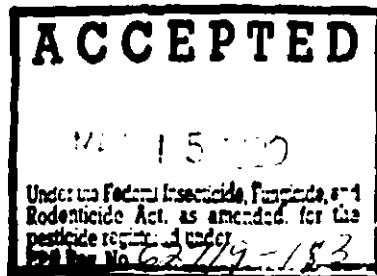
