Directions for Use

Apply Sonalan* 10G as a preplant incorporated treatment in the fall or in the spring prior to planting safflower. Refer to main product label for General Information, including mixing directions, application methods, soil incorporation, and application timing. In addition to weeds listed on the product label, Sonalan 10G is useful for control of ALS resistant kochia. Use the higher rate in rate range where difficult-to-control weeds or high weed populations are anticipated.

Broadcast Rates per Acre:

Soil Texture	Sonalan 10G (lb/acre)
Coarse	5.5 - 7.5
Medium	7.5 - 9.5
Fine	9.5 - 11.5

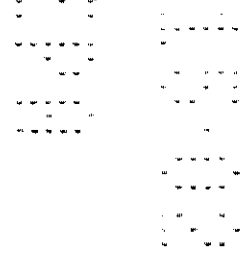
Precautions: To avoid crop injury, use the correct rate for the soil texture of the treatment area. Prolonged wet or cold soils, deep seed placement, soil crusting, or application overlaps may combine to cause slowed or reduced emergence.

Restrictions:

- Make only one application per crop season using ground broadcast equipment.
- Do not exceed 11.5 lb/acre per crop year.
- Do not allow grazing or harvest crop from treated soil for hay or silage.
- **In Montana and Wyoming:** Plant only rapeseed (canola), crambe, safflower or sunflower as rotational crops in the crop year following the crop treated with 11.5 pounds per acre of Sonalan 10G. In addition to rapeseed (canola), crambe, safflower or sunflower, spring seeded barley grown under irrigated conditions can be planted in the crop year following the crop treated with a 7.5 pound per acre rate of Sonalan 10G. If one of these specified crops is not planted, the land should be left idle or fallow for the entire year following the crop treated with Sonalan 10G.
