
The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, successfully REMOVES THE PRODUCT FROM THE SCOPE of PR Notice 93-7 once the comments (if any) on the attached sheet are addressed. Other than the alterations (if any) listed on the attached sheet, no further alterations to the labeling are necessary to reflect the requirements of the Worker Protection Standard.

Since your amendment proposes to delete uses directly and/or to delete uses implicitly through the use of exclusionary statements, the Agency will publish in the Federal Register a notice of receipt of your amendment to delete uses, as required by section 6(f)(1) of FIFRA. The Agency will defer action for 90 days from the date of the Federal Register notice to give affected minor users an opportunity to try to persuade you to retain the uses(s). When the comment period has expired, the Agency will approve the amendment unless you have withdrawn it, and stamp the amended labeling "accepted." Your stamped-accepted labeling will then be sent to you.

As described in Supplement A of PR Notice 93-11 (seif-verification option), you may sell and distribute product bearing the submitted labeling before you receive a copy of your stamped-accepted labeling. Note that your registration is not amended until the comment period required by section 6(f)(1) of FIFRA has expired and the Agency has approved the amendment. Therefore, you may withdraw your proposed amendment at any time during the comment period and until you receive your stamped-accepted labeling.

General Information

This turn tentilizer product contains GALLERY and TEAM, preemergence herbicides for control of certain broadleaf weeds and annual grasses in established furfgrasses. Apply in late summer or early fall to control fall approximately 3 weeks prior to germination of winter annual weeds, or in early spring, 3 weeks prior to germination of weeds which emerge in spring or early summer.

This product will not control established weeds. Existing weeds should be controlled with posternergence herbicides. To insure optimal fertilizer and herbicidal response, water treated areas as soon as possible after application. A single rainfall or sprinkler imigation of 0.5 inch or more is required to activate this product.

Important Use Precautions:

- Do not apply to non-turf areas such as flower beds or gardens. Take precautions to prevent inadvertent application from rotary-type applicators to such areas. Herbicides in this product prevent seed emergence and may injure bedding plants.
- This product may injure turl that is weakened due to severe winter weather or is not well
 established.
- Do not apply this product in the spring and summer to tall lescue turigrass seeded the previous fall.
- Do not apply in the spring to Bermudagrass which has been overseeded with winter annual
 grasses since thinning may occur.
- Do not apply to newly sprigged or hydromulched areas of Bermudagrass, St. Augustinegrass, centioedegrass or zovsiagrass until turl is well established.
- . Do not apply to dichondra.
- Do not apply to golf course putting greens.
- Any cultural practices that disturb the soil, such as aerification or verticutting should be done
 prior to application of this product.
- Do not overdose or overlap during application in such a way as to apply in excess of labeled rates as turt injury may occur.
- Reseeding: Do not reseed treated areas for a minimum of 8 weeks ofter a single application of 275 pounds per acre, or 12 to 16 weeds after a single application of 375 pounds per acre.
- Users who wish to use this product on turigrass species not recommended on this label may determine the suitability for such uses by treating a small area at a recommended rate. Prior to treating a larger area, the treatment should be observed for any sign of herbicidal injury for 30 to 60 days to determine if the treatment is safe to the target turi species. Application

Application Equipment and Application Techniques

Apply this product using a drop or rotary-type spreader designed to apply granular fertilizer. Calibrate application equipment prior to use according to manufacturer's directions. Check frequently to be sure equipment is operating properly and distributing product uniformly. Avoid use of spreaders that apply material in narrow concentrated bands. Avoid skips or overlaps as poor weed control or turf injury may occur. More uniform application may be achieved by spreading half of the required amount of product over the area and then applying the remaining half in swaths at right angles to the first. A sprash board mounted below the release point of droptype spreaders can improve the uniformity of product distribution.

Broadcast Application Rates

Apply GALLERY plus TEAM Turf Fertilizer at a rate of 250 to 375 pounds per acre. A minimum of 250 pounds per acre is recommended for optimum results.
