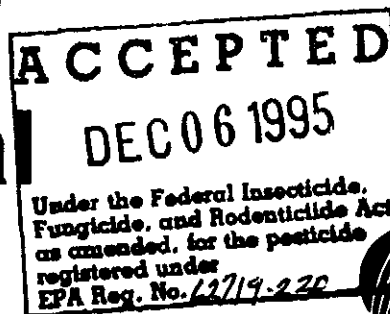

Exception Language Allowed by the Worker Protection Standard for Soil-Incorporated Uses of This Product Added to Agricultural Use Requirements Box

ATTENTION

- It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- Except as described in this supplemental labeling, use of Lorsban-4E according to this supplemental labeling is subject to all use precautions and limitations imposed by the label affixed to the container for Lorsban-4E.

Directions for Use

Worker Protection Standard requirements for Lorsban*-4E insecticide have been revised to include the "exception" statement in the Agricultural Use Requirements box which allows workers to enter the treated area if there will be no contact with anything that has been treated following soil-incorporated application of this product. The revised Agricultural Use Requirements box for Lorsban-4E is as follows (added text is underlined):

Agricultural Use Requirements

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE), and restricted entry interval. The requirements in this box only apply to uses of this product that are covered by the Worker Protection Standard.

Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 24 hours.

Exception: If the product is soil-injected or soil-incorporated, the Worker Protection Standard, under certain circumstances, allows workers to enter the treated area if there will be no contact with anything that has been treated.

PPE required for early entry to treated areas that is permitted under the Worker Protection Standard and that involves contact with anything that has been treated, such as plants, soil, or water, is:

- Coveralls
- Chemical-resistant gloves such as Barrier Laminate or Viton
- Shoes plus socks
