### Post Harvest Control of Codling Moth in Pear

#### ATTENTION

- Read the label affixed to the container for Lorsban®-4E insecticide before applying. Carefully follow all precautionary statements and applicable use directions.
- Use of Lorsban-4E according to this supplemental labeling is subject to all use precautions and limitations imposed by the label affixed to the container for Lorsban-4E.

#### Directions for Use

Refer to product label for Lorsban-4E for General Use Precautions, Mixing and Application instructions.

Apply 4 pints of Lorsban-4E per acre. Mix the specified dosage in 100 to 400 gallons of spray per acre and apply using an airblast speed sprayer or other suitable ground equipment.

#### Specific Use Restrictions:

- **Do not** make more than 1 post harvest application (prior to dormancy) per year.
- **Do not** harvest or use treated fruit for food or feed.
- **Do not** allow meat or dairy animals to graze in treated orchards.
- **Do not** enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval (REI) of 24 hours unless PPE required for early entry is worn.
- If unauthorized entry into a treated orchard cannot be prevented, then the orchard shall be posted while treated, unharvested fruit remains on the tree.
