Resubmission dated August 7, 2007 for Petition Number 3E6798.

#### Dear Dr. Racke:

The supplemental labeling for post-bloom application to apple tree trunk referred to above is acceptable with the following comments:

- 1) Revise the following restriction (the last bullet) and move it to be the first bullet: "This product may not be used if a pre-bloom application of any other chlorpyrifos containing product has been made during the year."
- 2) Revise third bullet to read: "Do not make more than one (1) post-bloom trunk application per year."
- 3) The protective clothing for handlers and applicators must be specified as the following: Workers making applications by ground boom sprayer must wear basic protective clothing (long shirt, long pants, socks and shoes), gloves, and a respirator with a protection factor of 5 (PF%); and, workers making applications by shielded hand gun must wear basic protective clothing (long shirt, long pants, socks and shoes), coveralls, and gloves.

- Treat only the lower 4 feet of the apple tree trunk.
- Do not make more than 1 application per year for borer control.
- Do not apply when wind speed is greater than 10 mph.
- Do not apply within 28 days of harvest.
- Do not allow meat or dairy animals to graze in treated orchards.
- Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval of 4 days unless PPE required for early entry is worn.
- Make only 1 application of Lorsban-4E to the apple tree trunk per year as either a pre-bloom OR postbloom application.

#### Proposed changes by amendment:

- 1. Deleted "If the available residue data...agree to discuss further mitigation." from Restrictions.
- 2. Added "Do not allow meat or dairy animals to graze in treated orchards." to Restrictions.
- 3. Added "Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted entry interval of 4 days unless PPE required for early entry is worn." to Restrictions.

### 07Aug07 – Additional proposed changes by amendment based upon August 3, 2007 conversation between Akiva Abramovitch (EPA) and Cindy Loy (DAS):

- 1. Specific Use Directions: Deleted "Up to 2 applications may be made with a minimum spray interval of 14 days between applications."
- 2. Restrictions: (1) Revised second bullet point to read "Do not make more than 1 application per year for borer control."; (2) added new bullet point "Make only 1 application of Lorsban-4E to the apple tree trunk per year as either a pre-bloom OR post-bloom application."
