General Information

Turflon II Weed Stick is a ready-to-use weed killer which controls many broad-leaf weeds in lawns and other areas including dandelions, plantains, clover, henbit, oxalis, spurge, wild violet and ground ivy.

How to Use: For best performance, Turflon II Weed Stick should be at least 75°F before use. Remove plastic protective cap. Grasp long thin tube with one hand and thicker outer tube with the other hand and twist to expose 1/4 to 1/2 inch of herbicidal wax beyond end of larger tube. Apply herbicidal wax directly to stems and leaves of weed with a twisting or wiping action. For patches of small-leaved weeds such as oxalis, clover and ground ivy, contact all leaves with a sweeping action. Use light pressure. It is not necessary to leave a visible wax coating on weed leaves for the product to perform.

After use, twist tube in opposite direction to retract herbicidal wax tip. Then replace protective cap.

When to Use: Turflon II Weed Stick may be used anytime when weeds are actively growing, preferably a day or two after mowing, when temperatures are above 75°F.

What to Look For After Treatment: Twisted weed growth and discoloration should appear in about 7 to 10 days. Weeds such as ground ivy may take 4 to 6 weeks to die.

Use Precautions: Do not touch herbicide wax tip to flowers, shrubs, or other desirable broad-leaf plants. Grasses should not be injured when the Turflon II Weed Stick is used as directed.
