Directions for Use

Treflan* HFP herbicide may be applied to established spearmint and peppermint as a soil incorporated treatment, by chemigation, or surface applied and watered-in. Apply during dormancy or semi-dormancy in late winter to spring or in the fall after harvest. Treflan HFP does not control established weeds, therefore, application must be made prior to germination time of target weeds (refer to product label for labeled weeds). Late winter to early spring application will control susceptible weeds that germinate in the spring and early summer and fall application will control susceptible fall germinating weeds. If mechanically incorporated, use equipment that will provide thorough soil mixing with minimal damage to the crop stand (refer to product label for incorporation equipment recommendations and labeled weeds).

Treflan HFP may be surface applied for annual grass control in established mint using chemigation, or ground, or aerial broadcast application equipment.

Chemigation: For chemigation application, apply at the recommended broadcast application rates. Read and follow label instructions for chemigation outlined in the main product label for Treflan HFP.

Surface Applications Activated by Rainfall or Irrigation: Surface applications of Treflan HFP may be activated by rainfall, sprinkler irrigation, or flood irrigation. Rainfall or a single overhead sprinkler irrigation of 0.5 acre inch or more is required to activate Treflan HFP. If rainfall or irrigation has not occurred within 3 days after application, mechanical incorporation is recommended to activate the treatment.
