

Precautionary Statements

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Avoid breathing dust and spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and water supplies.

First Aid

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If On Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.


If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water for five minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If Inhaled: Remove to fresh air if symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition appear and get medical attention immediately

Note To Physician: Chlorpyrifos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. If exposed, plasma and red blood cell cholinesterase tests may indicate significance of exposure (baseline data are useful). Atropine, only by injection, is the preferable antidote. Oximes, such as 2-PAM/protopam, may be therapeutic if used early; however, use only in conjunction with atropine. In case of severe acute poisoning, use antidote immediately after establishing an open airway and respiration.

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is toxic to birds and wildlife, and extremely toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal area below the mean high water mark. Drift and runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in adjacent aquatic sites. Cover or incorporate spills. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.



Directions for Use

Handling Precautions for insecticide Packets Do not remove insecticide packet from outer protective package except for immediate use. Do not allo insecticide packet to come in contact with water prior to use. Do not handle insecticide packet wet hands or gloves. Carefully reseal package containing unopened pouches after use and protein package from moleture.

General information

For use with the Raid Sprayer or other pump up sprayers.

Note: Packets are water soluble. Store in a dry place.

Pets can pick up fleas and ticks in outdoor areas around your home. Kill fleas before they get on your pet v. Dursban 50WSP.

Dursban 50WSP kills fleas, ticks and many other crawling insects. It is specially formulated to be effective on soil, grass, concrete and other areas where fleas can hide.

Preparation Open the outer protective package and remove a pouch containing the inner insecticide packet. _Open_the pouch and place the unopened insecticide packet into RAID Sprayer. Add water to the "fill line" on the RAID ... Sprayer. (When using other types of sprayers, mix one packet per 1-1/2 quarts of water.) DO NOT*OPEN INSECTICIDE PACKET. THE PACKET WILL DISSOLVE IN WATER. Do not allow the Josephicida. packet to become wet before adding to sprayer. Do not handle the insecticide packet with wet hands or gloves. Close sprayer and SHAKE WELL to dissolve packet. Pump sprayer 20-25 times. To spay, press lever on handle. Re-pump sprayer as needed during use. Shake sprayer periodically during use. 0.25%

Application

Spray areas of yard where pets frequent such as shaded areas, under trees, inside and near dog houses or kennels, etc. Apply a uniform spray to these areas. Also spray where flea infested wildlife such as rabbits, raccoons and opossums may frequent. Treat crawl spaces, sheds and woodpiles and other hiding spots where these animals frequent. Allow treated surfaces to dry before allowing pets to reenter. For difficult to reach areas, adjust nozzle to stream and treat thoroughly.

Coverage: 1-1/2 quarts of diluted product will treat approximately 375 square feet.

{Editors Note: This coverage would change accordingly depending on the packet size and sprayer volume.}

Cleanup: Use up entire contents of sprayer. Open sprayer and rinse with clear water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food or feed b, sprayer use, storage or disposal.

Storage: Store unused packets in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area. Store in a cool dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, or animal feed. Packets may become brittle when stored below 32 degrees F. Handle carefully to avoid breakage. Exposure to moisture or excessive handling of water soluble packets may cause breakage.

Pesticide Disposal: Dispose of pesticide spray mixture only in accordance with tabel use directions. Do not store diluted product.

Container Disposal: After all packets are used, dispose of carton in trash.
