Preparation

Open the outer protective package and remove a pouch containing the inner insecticide packet. Open the pouch and place the unopened insecticide packet into RAID Sprayer. Add water to the "Fill line" on the RAID Sprayer. (When using other types of sprayers, mix one packet per 1 1/2 quarts of water.) DO NOT OPEN INSECTICIDE PACKET. THE PACKET WILL DISSOLVE IN WATER. Do not allow the insecticide packet to become wet before adding to the sprayer. Do not handle the insecticide packet with wet hands or gloves. Close sprayer and SHAKE WELL to dissolve packet. Pump sprayer 20-25 times. To spray, press lever on handle. Re-pump sprayer as needed during use. Shake sprayer periodically during use.

[Editor's Note: These directions are based on a packet weight of 8 grams, which will yield a concentrations of 0.25% active ingredient in 1.5 quarts of finished spray. Directions for dilution will vary depending on the packet size and sprayer volume but a final concentration of 0.25% active ingredient will be maintained.]

Spray areas of yard where pets frequent such as shaded areas, under trees, inside and near dog houses or kennels, etc. Apply a uniform spray to these areas. Also spray where flea infested wildlife such as rabbits, raccoons, and opossums may frequent. Treat crawl spaces, sheds and woodpiles and other hiding spots where these animals frequent. Allow treated surfaces to dry before allowing pets to re-enter. For difficult to reach areas, adjust nozzle to stream and treat thoroughly.

Coverage: 1 1/2 quarts of diluted product will treat approximately 375 square feet.

[Editor's Note: This coverage would change accordingly depending on the packet size and sprayer volume.]

Clean-up: Use up entire content of sprayer. Open sprayer and rinse with clear water.
