Broadcast Treatment of Ornamental Turi

Apply 1/2 to 1 quart of Turflon Ester in 20 to 200 gallons of water per acre to control actively growing broadleaf weeds growing in perennial bluegrass, perennial ryegrass, or tall fescue. Do not use on other turfgrass species (see General Use Precautions) unless injury can be tolerated.
