On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

 - c. In the list of marketing claims, delete "No xylene," "No volatile organic compounds," "No V.O.C.'s," "No aromatic solvents," "Break-through formula," "Technology breakthrough," "Replaces (supplemental distributor's other

brand name)" [although the claim may be used if the "other brand name" is for another chlorpyrifos product]; and, "Controls fire ants for more than 30 days."

(The claim "Controls fire ants for more than 30 days" implies control of imported fire ants. Effective control of this pest requires treatment of their mounds. Perimeter treatment may prevent an occasional forager from entering a building, but this is not perceived to be a significant problem with imported fire ants.

- d. In the list of marketing claims, revise "Keeps on killing roaches for up to 12 weeks/90 days" and "Kills roaches for up to 12 weeks/90 days" to "Keeps on killing roaches for up to 8 weeks" and "Kills roaches for up to 8 weeks." Revise "Lasts up to 90 days/12 weeks" and "Long Lasting Up to 90 days/12 weeks" to "Lasts up to 8 weeks" and "Long Lasting Up to 8 weeks."
- e. On page 4, revise the precautionary statement to "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."
- f. On page 4, in the First Aid section (Statement of Practical Treatment), you may delete directions for "IF INHALED."
- 3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Indoors Pests

Spray Dursban* NXS05 insecticide to areas where ants, carpet beetles, centipedes, clover mites, cockroaches (including strains resistant to other insecticides), crickets, earwigs, firebrats, fleas, flour beetles, millipedes, silverfish, sowbugs, spiders and ticks are found or occur including corners; cracks and crevices in walls; along and behind baseboards; beneath and behind sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; around doors, windows, plumbing and other utility installations.

For control of fleas and ticks, vacuum infested area then spray infested areas, and other areas where these pests may be present. Do not treat pets or their bedding with this product. For best results, old bedding should be removed and cleaned or replaced. To control the source of flea infestation, pets inhabiting the treated premises should be treated with a product registered for application to pets.

Perimeter Pests

To prevent insect pests from entering structures, spray where pests are found including cracks and crevices, along sidewalks, patios, building foundation, around windows, screens, doors, light fixtures, utility installations or other areas pests may enter building. Pests controlled include ants, bees, beetles, clover mites, cockroaches, crickets, earwigs, fleas, flies, hornets, millipedes, mosquitoes, scorpions, silverfish, sowbugs, spiders, ticks, wasps, yellowjackets.

Ornamental Pests

Spray insect infested flowers, shrubs, evergreens, vines, and other ornamental plants to thoroughly wet foliage, branches, or trunks. Repeat applications can be made at 7 day intervals. Insect pests controlled include ants, aphids, armyworms, bagworms, beetles, boxelder bugs, borers, budworms, caterpillars, cutworms, fall webworms, grasshoppers, hornworms, lace bugs, leafhoppers, leafrollers, mealybugs, mites, moths, psyllids, tentmakers, thrips, spittlebugs, and whiteflies.

Note: Environmental factors can have effects on plant damage when plants have been treated with an insecticide. Dursban NXS05 has been tested on numerous ornamental plants without causing significant damage.
