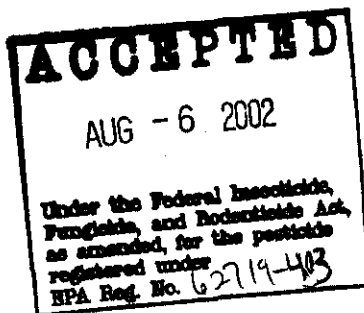
1. **Product Name:** Changed to "Stam* Technical" with the generic descriptor "Herbicide."
