- Reorder the precautionary statements to read as follows: Harmful if swallowed. Causes Moderate Eye Irritation. Harmful if Absorbed Through Skin. Avoid contact with skin eyes or clothing.
- Remove the vertical space above the sentence beginning "Avoid contact with . .
- Change the second sentence from: "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco." to: "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, tobacco or using the toilet."

Page 3 – Warranty Limitations and Disclaimer:

Change the sentence: "Dow AgroSciences expressly disclaims any implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose and, except as set forth in the above paragraph, any other express or implied warranties." to: "To the extend permitted by law, Dow AgroSciences expressly disclaims any implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose and, except as set forth in the above paragraph, any other express or implied warranties."

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You must submit one (1) copy of the final printed label before you release the product for shipment. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this letter or the next printing of the label whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label.

Insert pressure rinsing nozzle in the side of the container, and rinse at about 40 psi for at least 30 seconds. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Then offer for recycling if available, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or by other procedures allowed by state and local authorities.
