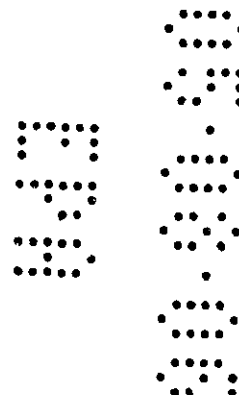

Kelthane 50WSP is a contact miticide, not a systemic pesticide. Mites must come in contact with Kelthane 50WSP as it is sprayed or be exposed to residues on the leaf and/or fruit surface. Since mites often infest the under surfaces of leaves and fruits, effective control requires an application that thoroughly and uniformly coats all foliar plant surfaces. For maximum effectiveness, apply Kelthane 50WSP to low populations of mites.

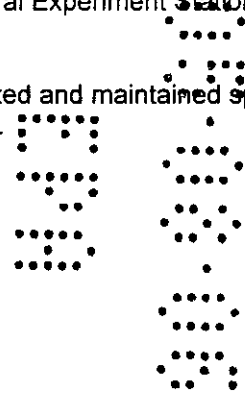

Application Rate: Apply as a dilute or concentrate ground spray with a properly calibrated and maintained sprayer in sufficient water to assure thorough and uniform coverage of foliage and fruit surfaces.



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Spray Adjuvants: Kelthane 50WSP may be used with or without any additional adjuvants. A spreader-sticker is beneficial in improving the spray coverage on difficult-to-wet foliage and to smooth out spray deposits. Kelthane 50WSP should only be combined with a spreader-sticker that has been proven safe to crops.

- Do not exceed 1.5 lb ai dicofol per acre per application.
- Do not make more than 1 application per year.

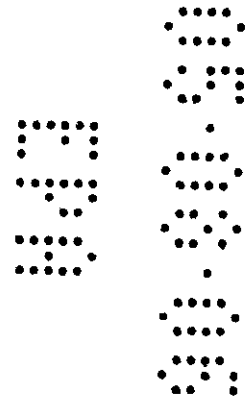
