Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool dry well-ventilated area.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. Container Disposal
