- d. Use Directions for Commercial Cotton Seed Treatment: Add the sentence "Do not tank-mix with products whose labels contain a prohibition against tank mixing."
- e. Use Directions for Commercial Cotton Seed Treatment Label Treated Seed:

Change the first sentence to "This seed is treated with Nu-Flow M-40 which contains the active ingredient myclobutanil." Move the sentences "Do not graze cotton plants grown from treated seed. Store away from feed ans foodstuffs." so that they fall inside the quotation marks.

- 3. You must submit a Confidential Statement of Formula with the current registrant name and address:
- 4. Submit one (1) copy of the revised final printed label before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Use Directions for Commercial Cotton Seed Treatment

Nu-Flow* M-40 fungicide is recommended as a seed treatment to protect against sore shin (*Rhizoctonia solani*) and black root rot (*Thielaviopsis basicola*) which impairs cotton seed germination and seedling development. Nu-Flow M-40 may be applied to dry seed with conventional slurry or mist seed treating equipment. For best results, the seed must be completely and uniformly covered with fungicide. Nu-Flow M-40 can be tank-mixed with other properly labeled cottonseed protectants such as Apron TL fungicide for Pythium control.

Label Treated Seed "This seed is treated with Nu-Flow M-40. Do not use for food, feed, oil production or any other purpose except planting." Do not graze cotton plants grown from treated seed. Store away from feed and foodstuffs.

In California, this product must be applied through a closed system such as WECO-RED (Returnable Evacuation Device).

Use 0.05 to 0.0675 lb (0.8 to 1.0 oz) of Nu-Flow M-40 (0.02 - 0.027 lb active ingredient) per 100 lb cotton seed to reduce seedling damage caused by sore shin (*Rhizoctonia solani*) and black root rot (*Thielaviopsis basicola*).

For cotton seed treatment, always use Nu-Flow M-40 with an EPA approved dye or colorant that imparts an unnatural color to the seed.
