Systhane M40 may be applied to dry seed with conventional slurry or mist seed treating equipment. For best results, the seed must be completely and uniformly covered with fungicide. Systhane M40 can be tank mixed with other properly labeled cotton seed protectants such as Apron TL fungicide for Pythium control. Do not tank mix with products whose labels contain a prohibition against tank mixing.
