Application Timing

Summer: When applied as a summer (chemical) fallow application, apply in the initial application to establish summer fallow in the spring or early summer. Do not apply as a summer (chemical) fallow application after July 1.

Fall: Apply FirstStep A at a rate of 1.36 fl oz per acre tank mixed with FirstStep B at a rate of 13.5 fl oz per acre in the fall prior to planting wheat (including durum), barley, rye, triticale, and oats.

Apply in the summer or fall as directed above only when weeds are actively growing, in the 2 to 4 leaf stage except where noted in the Weeds Controlled or Suppressed section. Extreme growing conditions such as drought or near freezing temperatures prior to, at, or following time of application may reduce weed control and increase the risk of crop injury at all stages of growth. Only weeds that have emerged at the time of application are controlled. Best results are obtained from application made to seedling weeds. If foliage is wet at the time of application, control may be decreased.

Spray Coverage

Use sufficient spray volume to provide thorough coverage and a uniform spray pattern. Do not broadcast apply in less than 3 gallons of total spray volume per acre. For best results and to minimize spray drift, apply in a spray volume of 10 gallons or more per acre. As vegetative canopy or weed density increases, increase spray volume to obtain equivalent weed control. Use only nozzle types and spray equipment designed for herbicide application. To reduce spray drift, follow precautions in Avoid Injurious Spray Drift section.

Restrictions:

- Preharvest Interval: Do not apply with 60 days before grain harvest.
- Do not apply more than 1.36 fl oz of FirstStep A per acre per growing season.
- Livestock may be grazed on treated crops seven days following application.
