The subject registration will be limited to *Bacillus thuringiensis* Cry1A.105 and Cry2Ab2 proteins and the genetic material necessary for their production (vector PV-ZMIR245) in MON 89034 (OECD Unique Identifier: MON-89Ø34-3), *Bacillus thuringiensis* Cry1F protein and the genetic material necessary for its production (vector PHP8999) in TC1507 (OECD Unique Identifier: DAS-Ø15Ø7-1), and *DvSnf7* dsRNA [Double-stranded ribonucleic acid transcript comprising a *DvSnf7* inverted repeat sequence derived from western corn rootworm (*Diabrotica virgifera virgifera*)] and *Bacillus thuringiensis* Cry3Bb1 protein and the genetic material necessary for their production (vector PV-ZMIR10871) in MON 87411 corn (OECD Unique Identifier: MON-87411-9)] for use in field corn.
- 4. This plant-incorporated protectant may be combined through conventional breeding with other registered plant-incorporated protectants that are similarly approved for use in combination, through conventional breeding, with other registered plant-incorporated protectants to produce inbred corn lines and hybrid corn varieties with combined pesticidal traits.
