It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

TREATMENT ON CRACKS AND CREVICES.

To Kill Roaches, Ants, Crickets, Silverfish, Scorpions, Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas and Carpet Beetles: Spray in small amounts directly into cracks, crevices, baseboards and cabinets. Attach the straw to valve for better results.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

To Kill Roaches, Ants, Spiders, Centipedes, Silverfish and Other Insects: Spray cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. **Do not spray animals.** Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Also treat dogs and cats with a RED CIRCLE flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

FOR FLYING INSECTS:

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

STORAGE: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. **DISPOSAL:** Replace cap, wrap container in newspaper and put in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Contains petroleum distillate. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin.

Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. Remove pets, birds and cover aquariums before spraying.

Statement of Practical Treatment

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting due to aspiration hazard. Get medical attention immediately. **If Inhaled:** Remove person to fresh air. Contact a physician if warranted. **If On Skin:** Immediately wash skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. **If In Eyes:** Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Physical Hazards
