STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FICSAN PLUGS are recommended for killing trees in forests, parks, fence rows; in highway and railroad rights-of-ways; and in industrial and residential sites. It may be used for killing trees standing in water and in wetlands.

FICSAN PLUGS will kill the following species:

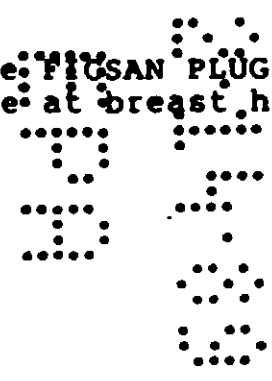

Trees will die if injected with FICSAN PLUGS. Inject the PLUGS only with FIC tools. For effective results, the PLUGS must be applied such that the content of active ingredient is in direct contact with the tree's phloem tissue (the first living tissue under the bark).

Use precautions: 1) Do not apply to trees when their sap is frozen. 2) Do not apply to trees that may be later standing in water above the point of injection.

For trees with 2.5 inches or less diameter at breast height (DBH), inject one FICSAN PLUG per tree.

For trees with greater than 2.5 inches DBH, inject one FICSAN PLUG every 10 inches, evenly around the circumference of the tree at breast height.



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The contents of the FICSAN PLUG moves throughout the tree from the point of injection to all roots and shoots. Effects appear gradually (normally within 2 to 4 months during the vegetative growth stage of the treated tree) beginning with wilting, followed with yellowing and browning of the foliage, and finally with death of all roots and shoots.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, foodstuffs, feed or seed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE:

Keep container closed. At the end of each use period, replace unused plugs in original container and re-seal.

DISPOSAL:

Wastes resulting from the use of this product that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticide disposal or in accordance with applicable federal, state and local procedures.
