#### DIRECTION FOR USE

It is a violatiion of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. FICSAN PLUGS are recommended for killing trees in forests, parks, fence rows, in highway and railroad right-of-ways; and industrial and residential sites.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For any requirements specific to your State or Tribe, or consult the agency responsible for pesticide regulation.

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PICSAN PLUGS may be used for killing trees in areas where surface water is present or in intertidal areas, however do not apply to trees that may later be standing in water above the point of injection.

PICSAN PLUGS will kill the following species: Ash, oak, Aspen(quaking), Sourwood, Dogwood, Sumac, Willow, Elm, Sweet Gum, Hawthorn.

Trees will die if injected with PICSAN PLUGS. Inject the PLUGS only with FIC tools. For effective results, the PLUGS must be applied such that the content of active ingredient is in direct contact with the tree's phloem tissue (the first living tissue under the bark).

For trees with 2.5 inches or less diameter at breast height (DBH), inject one FICSAN PLUG per tree. For trees greater than 2.5 inches DBH, inject one FICSAN PLUG every 6-8 inches, evenly around the circumference of the tree at breast height.

The contents of the PICSAN PLUG moves throughout the tree from the point of injection to all roots and shoots. Effects appear gradually (normally within 2 to 4 months during the vegetative growth stage of the treated trees) beginning with wilting, followed with yellowing and browning of the foliage, and finally with death of all roots and shoots.
