This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 62896-1" to your label before you release the product for shipment.

b. Revise the precautionary statements to read as follows:

Hazards to Human and Domestic Animals
DANGER

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

c. Statement of Practical Treatment should read as follows:

If in eyes: Call a physician. Keep eye lids open and flush with a gentle steady stream of water for 15 minutes.

If swallowed. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg white or gelatin mixture, or if these are not available a large quantity of water. Avoid alcohol.

d. The signal word should be changed from "Warning" to read "Danger." It should be placed on the front panel.

e. A copy of "The Label" is enclosed for your assistance.

f. The following statement must be added directly below the "Directions for Use" heading: "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling". Remove the existing statement, "Federal law prohibits...with labeling."

g. The Agency does not anticipate a product such as yours to be efficacious as a disinfectant and/or sanitizer. Therefore, delete all references on the label to disinfection and sanitization (i.e., "effectively disinfect and sanitize"); efficacy data must be submitted and approved by the Agency before such claims are added to the label.

h. The statement, KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN", must be added to the front panel of the label.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

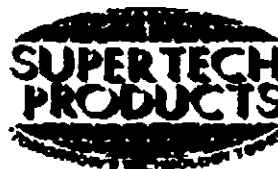
