2. Make the labeling changes listed below to the label and release to the market for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 62982-1."
- b. Since the lower certified is it use the word "type" or "active ingredient" on the label and delete the word "active ingredient" from the label. The word "type" should be placed in the same position as the word "active ingredient" on the label.
- c. Delete the word "type" from the label.
- d. Add the word "type" to the label in the same position as the word "active ingredient" on the label.
- e. Add the word "type" to the label in the same position as the word "active ingredient" on the label.

- f. Change "peroid" to "period."
- g. Combine the use directions of your two labels by changing the second paragraph of your "CARPET" directions as follows:

To spread and force powder deep into carpet where fleas and their larvae exist, brush lightly with broom or use an approved commercial applicator.

- h. Insert the following separate paragraph after "carpets":

NOTE: If high adult flea populations make it undesirable to wait 3 weeks, apply a pesticide designed to kill adult fleas before, or in conjunction with this product.

- i. Revise the "Storage and Disposal" section for your one pound paper container as follows: Add "securely" before "wrap."
- j. Revise your "Storage and Disposal" section for your 5-gallon, plastic pail label by modifying your "Container Disposal" as follows:

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

3. Within 15 months of registration, submit the results of a 1-year storage stability study (Guidelines Reference No. 63-17).

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

CARPETS:Apply to dry surfaces only.Apply directly to carpet at the rate of one pound per 100 square feet (31.5mg/sq.in.) Brush lightly with broom to force powder deep into carpet where fleas and their larvae exist.Allow to remain for a period of three weeks to achieve maximum flea control in carpets.

Any powder visible after application must be removed.Reapply as necessary.

UPHOLSTERY:Remove loose cushions.Sprinkle along creases and into corners.Brush lightly to work powder into folds and creases. Do not apply to exposed fabric.

Any powder visible after application must be removed.Reapply as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE:Store in original container,in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL:Do not reuse empty container.Wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

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
