The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin RED, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **<u>not</u>** being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statement of Formulation (CSF) listed below. Any CSFs other than those listed below are superseded.

USE RESTRICTIONS

Do not apply this product that will contact workers or other persons either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

Do not use in aircraft.
