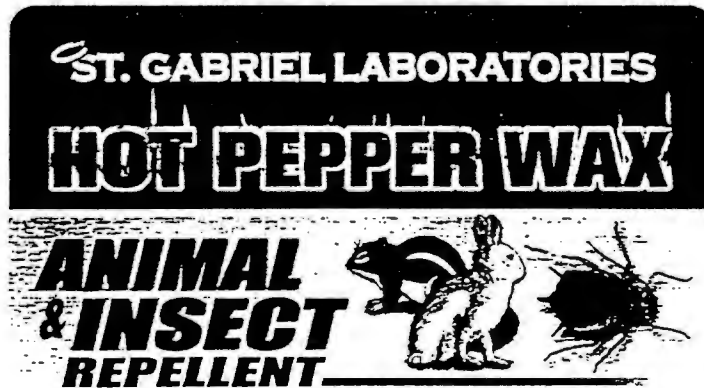

CONCENTRATE LABEL: AGRICULTURAL USE

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas until the restricted entry interval of 12 hours after the spray has dried.

PPE required for early entry to treated areas that is permitted under the Worker Protection Standard and that involves contact with anything that has been treated such as plants, soil, or water, i.e.: coveralls, waterproof gloves, shoes plus socks, and protective eye wear.

Use restrictions:

INSECTS: To repel aphids, spider mites, thrips, whiteflies, lace bugs, and leafhoppers, spray this product on foliage, stems, buds, fruits, and blooms. This product can be used on fruits, vegetables, citrus, root crops, legumes, indoor/outdoor ornamentals and grasses.

RABBITS AND TREE SQUIRRELS: To repel rabbits and tree squirrels, spray this product on foliage, stems, buds, fruits, and blooms. This product can be used on fruits, vegetables, citrus, root crops, legumes, indoor/outdoor ornamentals and grasses.

ALL USES: Apply this product using spray equipment. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Labeling, Application, and Retreatment Directions for Plants: Apply this product, as stated below, as a foliar spray to the leaves, stems, fruits, and flowers of the plant until wet. Do not drain roots in soil or media. Do not apply when rain is expected within 24 hours.

IF TREATMENT AREA IS LESS THAN 1 ACRE: INITIAL RATE is 1 part of this product to 16 parts Water (1oz. or 16Tbs. per gallon of water). Apply until foliage is wet or a maximum of 3 gallons prepared solution per 1000 square feet. Repeat application in 3-7 days, for 2-3 weeks, until control is established. **ONCE CONTROL IS ESTABLISHED** use MAINTENANCE RATE of 1 part of this product to 32 parts Water (4oz. or 8Tbs. per gallon of water) every 2-4 weeks, as necessary to maintain control.

IF TREATMENT AREA IS 1 ACRE OR MORE: INITIAL RATE is 1 gallon of this product per 16 gallons of water. Use 100 gallons of solution per acre. Apply until foliage is wet. Repeat application if necessary, in 1-2 weeks, until control is established. **ONCE CONTROL IS ESTABLISHED** use MAINTENANCE RATE of 2 gallons of this product to a minimum of 100 gallons WATER per acre, every 2-4 weeks, as necessary to maintain control.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals:

Caution: Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

Applicators and other handlers must wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):

- Long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- Waterproof gloves
- Shoes plus socks
- Protective Eye Wear

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

Environmental Hazards:

Pesticide Storage:

Store container in areas inaccessible to children. Keep securely closed.

Container Disposal:

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incinerator, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. FIRST AID

IF INHALED • Move person to fresh air.

IF SWALLOWED • Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
