DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into the human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to preclean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical devices prior to sterilization or high-level disinfection.

GENERAL USE DIRECTIONS

USES: For use on hard, non-porous surfaces such as floors, walls, metal surfaces, painted surfaces, exterior bowl surfaces, empty basins, showers, conductive flooring, and laboratory fixtures. For use in hospitals, nursing homes, schools, colleges, medical clinics, dental offices, veterinary clinics, airports, hotels, motels, office buildings, and households.

APPLICATION: Use RTU Phenolic Germicidal Detergent for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes in a single application. For disinfecting, remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits, then thoroughly wet surfaces. RTU Phenolic Germicidal Detergent is extremely versatile and can be applied with a mop, sponge, cloth, coarse spray, or soaking. The solution is not to be reused. Rinsing is not necessary on floor surfaces unless floors are to be waxed or polished. Tuberculocidal effectiveness is in 10 minutes at 20°C.

Contact Time: Use undiluted on precleaned hard, non-porous surfaces for a contact time of 10 minutes at 25°C. Use water (10) minute contact time for disinfection against all other bacteria, fungi, and viruses claimed (listed on label).

Disposal of Infectious Materials: Blood and other body fluids should be auto-ferred and disposed of according to federal, state, and local regulations for infectious waste disposal.
